ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

Brushwood Center is seeking an enthusiastic candidate with experience in data collection and evaluation as well as a passion for public health and the outdoors. The Fellow of Health, Equity, and Nature Accelerator will work closely with the Director of Health Equity, and Nature Accelerator developing a Health and Nature Equity report for Lake County. Additionally, the Fellow will work on operationalizing a 3–6-month pilot program for nature-based healthcare solutions with Medicaid or Medicare partners. The ideal candidate for this role will be able to apply Brushwood Center's commitment to equity, diversity, and inclusion to all aspects of their role.

About the Health, Equity, and Nature Accelerator:

Brushwood Center's Health, Equity, and Nature Accelerator aims to activate healthcare investment in nature-based solutions and drive collaboration among community, governmental, environmental, and healthcare sectors in Lake County and the larger Chicago region. The Accelerator was born in response to growing community demand and momentum for systemic changes to address racial and ethnic

inequities at the intersection of health, climate, and nature. Building on Brushwood Center's decades of on-the-ground community engagement experience in Lake County, the Accelerator also responds directly to the lessons Brushwood Center took from our pandemic-response work.

Responsibilities include the following:

- 1. Conduct qualitative interviews with community members and partners.
- 2. Conduct data analysis and summarization as well as help develop policy recommendations to address access to nature and environmental justice in the context of public health
- 3. Help assist with final creation of Lake County Health and Nature Equity report for Lake County. This includes creation of report, presentation, webpage, and social media messaging, as well as presenting to elected officials, regional conferences and networks.

QUALIFICATIONS

We are seeking a dynamic, collaborative professional leader with at least two years of experience in data collection, analysis, and evaluation. This individual will be adaptable, analytical, and highly organized. Key qualifications include the following:

- Exceptionally well organized with strong time management skills.
- Experience in collecting qualitative data and analysis.
- A technical skillset that includes some proficiency in programming languages/software, including but not limited to MS Excel, Google Sheets, SQL, Tableau, Python, QGIS and R.
- A degree in environmental science, public health, or equivalent with an interest in environmental justice, climate change (preferred, but other relevant environmental work experience is considered - internships, volunteer experience etc.)
- A solid foundation of math and science coursework.
- Community engagement experience.
- Drive to address racism and create race equity with partners and team members.
- Ability to commute to Brushwood Center and other meeting locations in the Chicago region.
